
UK Architects Declare - Guide to the Practice Action Masterclasses

Masterclass 2: Understanding Impact

This workshop helped practitioners to measure and reduce their impact by developing an understanding of the relative impact of project and business carbon footprints, reporting against scope 1-3 emissions, and carrying out early-stage life cycle assessments.
